MYP Assessment Criteria

Students are assessed against four equally weighted assessment criteria. Each criterion has eight possible achievement levels (1–8), divided into four bands with unique descriptors that teachers use to make judgments about students' work.

- Criterion A: Analysing
- Criterion B: Organising
- Criterion C: Producing Text
- Criterion D: Using Language

World view and a personal interpretation of how we see the world	
Statement of Inquiry: Universal emotions and themes of the human experience are conveyed through the author's deliberate chosen genre.	
American Born Chinese	
Statement of Inquiry: The medium of literature conveys stereotypes and folklore.	
Persepolis	
Statement of Inquiry: The medium of literature conveys the geographical, historical and gender contexts.	
House on Mango Street	
Statement of Inquiry: Our identity is shaped by decisions, actions, experiences and cultural influence.
