### MYP Assessment Criteria

Students are assessed against four equally weighted assessment criteria. Each criterion has eight possible achievement levels (1–8), divided into four bands with unique descriptors that teachers use to make judgments about students' work.

- Criterion D: Using Language

Statement of Inquiry: Enjoyment of creative self-expression may be extended through careful consideration of structural and stylistic choices.	
World Cinema and Perspectives	
Statement of Inquiry: Creators of films make deliberate choices in order to convey a particular cultural perspective, purpose and meaning to target their audience.	
Speculative Worlds	
Statement of Inquiry: Speculative genres present perspectives on universal themes relating to what it means to be human in a functioning society.
