MYP Assessment Criteria

Students are assessed against four equally weighted assessment criteria. Each criterion has eight possible achievement levels (1–8), divided into four bands with unique descriptors that teachers use to make judgments about students' work.

- Criterion A: Comprehending spoken and visual text
- Criterion B: Comprehending written and visual text
- Criterion C: Communicating in response to spoken, written and visual text
- Criterion D: Using language in spoken and written form

Statement of Inquiry: As orientation in time and space changes, so too must context and conventions of language.
