# About the Learning Resource Centre



The Learning Resource Centre (LRC) is a well equipped flexible learning space, with a wide range of ICT designed to maximize individualised instruction and support student achievement.

Targeted assistance is offered for students enrolled in specialised programs, or those requiring additional support. Assistance is offered by experienced teachers and learning support assistants in individualized and small group tutoring.

Though literacy and numeracy are the main focus there is a strong focus on social development, time



The LRC is for all students. The number, frequency and scope of sessions attended by students is related to the individual student's needs.

Students who are enrolled in Special Needs programs, identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander or are identified as Gifted and Talented are offered sessions that support their individual learning goals and targets.

## **Learning Support Program and Integration Support Program**

Students in the Integration Support Program (ISP) and the Learning Support Program (LSP) are working towards attaining the goals identified in their Individual Learning Plans (ILP'S) by working in small groups or with individual support. These students receive support both in the LRC and in their regular classes.

## **Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Students**

In the Learning Resource Centre, students of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander descent (ATSI) are working towards attaining the goals identified in their Personalised Learning Plans (PLP's).
