## Unit of Inquiry *Who we are*

### Central Idea:

Understanding ourselves can help us to have positive relationships.

### Lines of Inquiry:

PERSPECTIVE: An inquiry into how we are the same and different to others.

CONNECTION: An inquiry into the relationships that we have.

FUNCTION: An inquiry into how we can interact with fairness, kindness and teamwork.

### How you can help at home?

- Support your child to build independence by packing and carrying their own bag.
- Talk to your child about what they are learning about themselves

### Literacy:

- We begin our journey learning our letters and sounds through *UFLI*
- We are exploring how books work
- We are learning to convey meaning through drawing and mark making

### How you can help at home?

- Read! Continue to share books, stories and poems with your child
- Write! Provide your child with lots of tools to write and chances to practice - writing lists, a letter to Grandma, labels for the home!

### Numeracy:

- Our big focus in kindergarten is on counting! In term 1 we are working on counting from zero to ten, and learning how to represent numbers with numerals, materials, ten frames, tally marks and words
- We are learning how to represent what we are learning about each other using data - we'll create lots of charts to show information about our classes!

### How you can help at home?

- Count with your child! Count while you pair socks, go shopping or even just when walking!
- Talk about numbers in the environment
