Unit of Inquiry

Where we are in place and time

Central Idea:

Human migration leads to transformation in people, places, cultures and environments.

Lines of Inquiry:

- **Causation:** An inquiry into the economic, political, and social causes of migration.
- **Perspective:** An inquiry into the role of significant individuals and groups in shaping events and the characteristics of a place.
- **Change:** An inquiry into the resulting impact of these changes on First Nations peoples, new arrivals, and the natural environment.

How you can help at home?

How have our lives changed over time?

Literacy:

- Structured phonics lessons daily
- Building blocks of sentences, ensuring students are able to create pieces of writing
- Exploring Historical Fiction texts

How you can help at home?

Ask your children what they are working on in writing, encourage them to read daily. Expose them to a wider range of literature.

Numeracy:

- Multiplication and Division
- Perimeter and Area
- Fractions and Decimals

How you can help at home?

Math is everywhere! Encourage your child to engage with the mathematical world in everyday situations. Let them handle money at the shops, count the change, or calculate the time needed to travel from one place to another.
