Unit of Inquiry

Who We Are

This term we will be exploring the transdisciplinary theme 'Who We Are.'

Central Idea: Our emotions and our actions can influence our communities

Lines of Inquiry:

- **Perspective** - An inquiry into how understanding our emotions and how to self regulate builds our resilience.
- **Causation** - An inquiry into how our identities are made up of values and beliefs that create diversity, inclusion and wellbeing.
- **Change** - An inquiry into how we contribute to our communities to create a sense of belonging.

How you can help at home?

Sharing your values and beliefs at home and talking about our similarities and differences. Conversations about emotions and naming emotions can also help children identify the different emotions they experience. Sharing what helps you relax is also a great conversation to have.

Literacy:

- Structured phonics lessons daily
- Reading to improve fluency and comprehension as well as for interest
- Daily writing

How you can help at home?

Ask your children what they are working on in writing, encourage them to read daily or read to your children daily. Notice examples of words and writing in the home and community.

Numeracy:

- Number and place value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Fractions

How you can help at home?

Maths is everywhere! Encourage your child to engage with the mathematical world in everyday situations. Let them handle money at the shops, count the change, or calculate the time needed to travel from one place to another.
