Unit of Inquiry

Who We Are

This term SGP3-6RR will be exploring the transdisciplinary Theme 'Who we are' by investigating our personal experiences and changes so far. The focus will be to communicate our stories through the creation of a picture book.

Central Idea: As we grow and change, learning to regulate our emotions and navigate digital and physical relationships helps us understand who we are.

Lines of Inquiry:

- **Change** - An investigation into how biological and social shifts influence our developing sense of self and emotional regulation.
- **Connection** - An inquiry into how our online choices—such as digital footprints and cyber safety—affect our relationships and physical wellbeing.
- **Perspective** - An exploration of how personal and societal values shape our integrity and the way we navigate consent in different contexts.

How you can help at home?

Given our focus on relationships, ask your child how they get to know others. What are the changes they have experienced since Kindergarten?

Literacy:

- Structured phonics lessons daily
- Building blocks of sentences, ensuring students are able to create pieces of writing that make sense for descriptive writing.

How you can help at home?

Ask your children what they are working on in writing, encourage them to read daily. Expose them to a range of picture and extended writing .

Numeracy:

- Focus on revisiting Number
- Addition and Subtraction
- Developing and building understanding of 2D and 3D shapes

How you can help at home?

Math is everywhere! Encourage your child to engage with the mathematical world in everyday situations. Let them count items in the house or when they are out in the community. Get them to identify where numbers are important.
